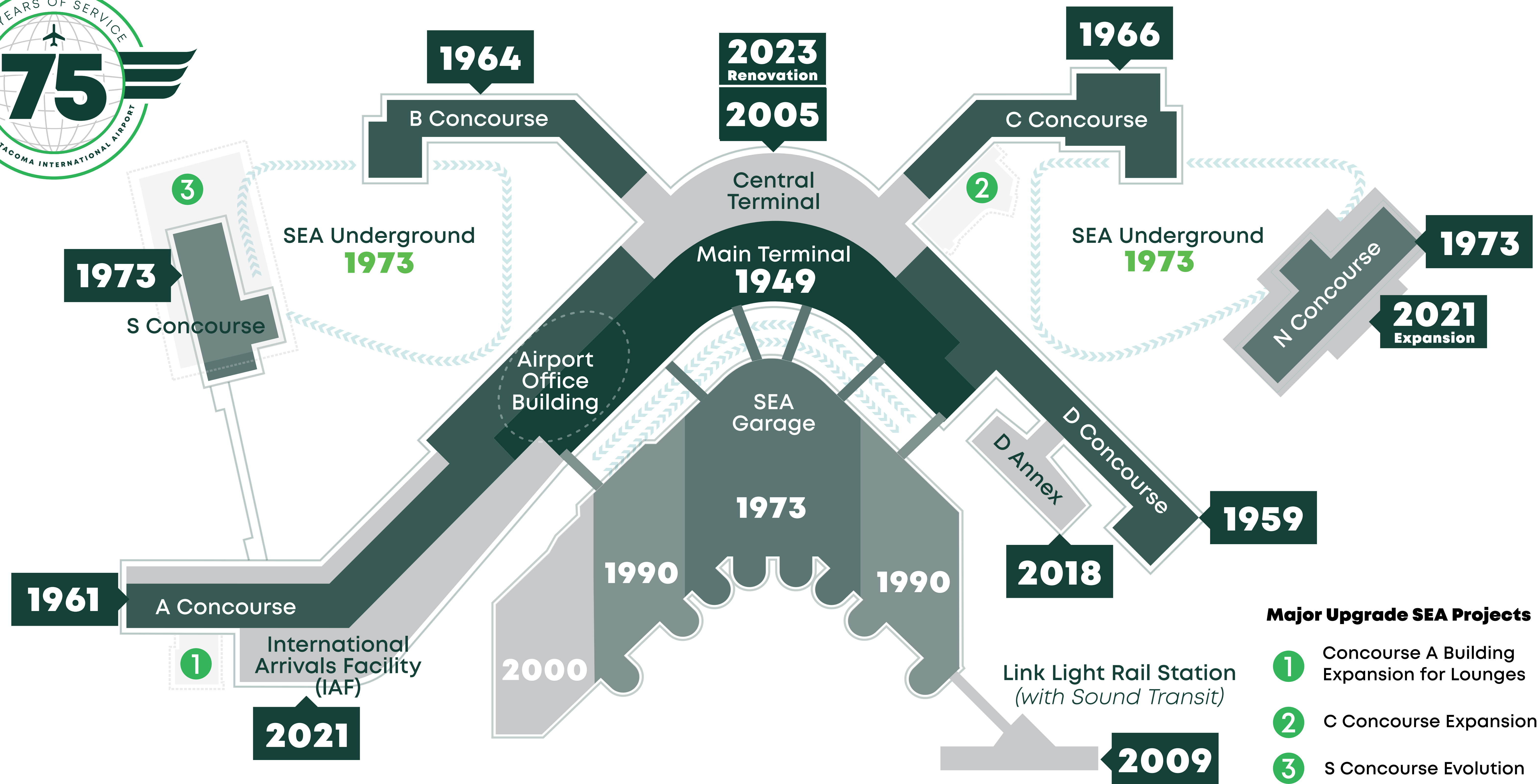


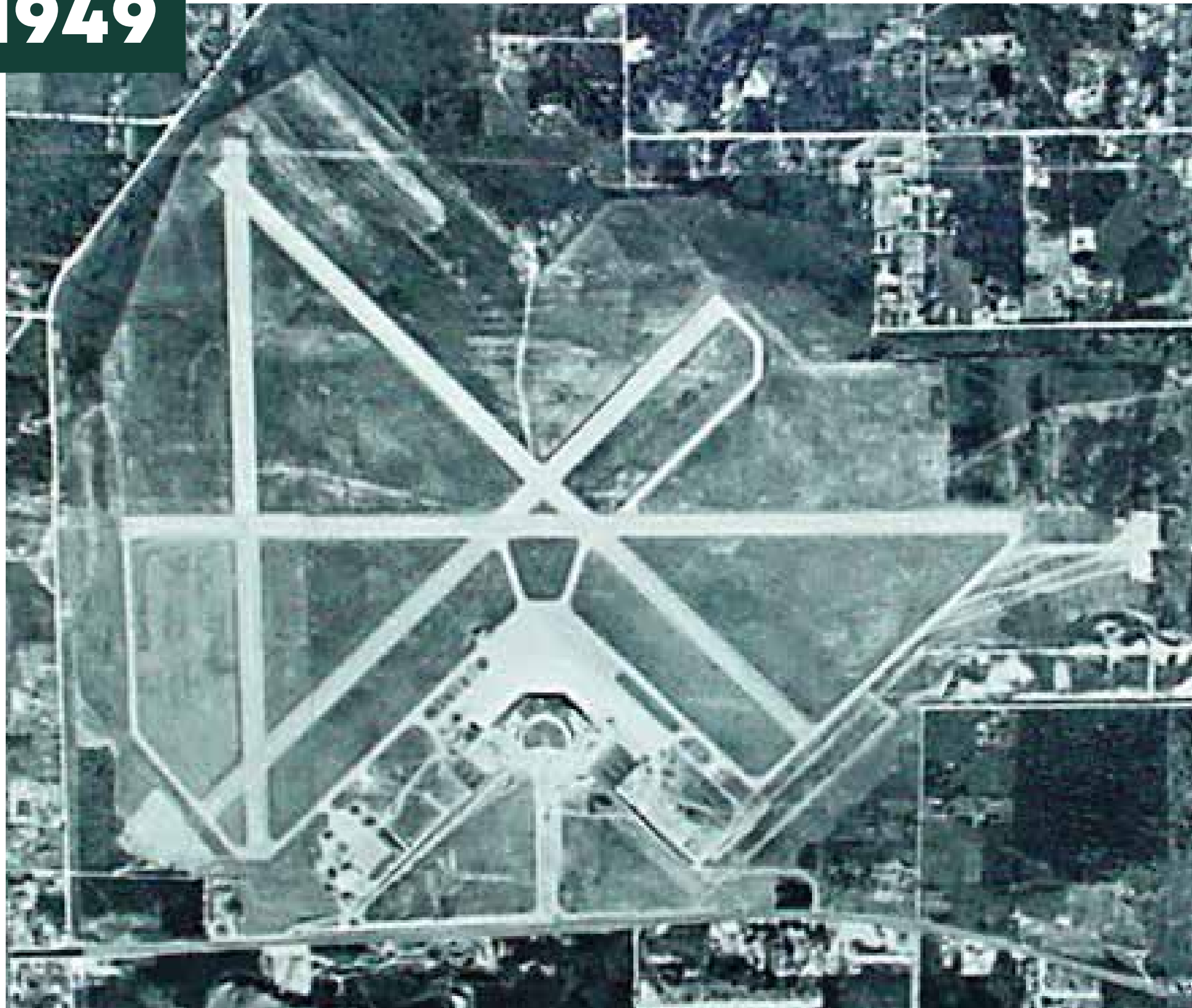


CONSTRUCTION MILESTONES

 - 1943**: Construction of new airport begins at Bow Lake, current airport site.
 - 1944**: Airport dedicated as Seattle-Tacoma Airport with arrival of United Airlines DC-3 Mainliner. Passengers wait in "The Pantry," a Quonset hut with a wood-burning potbellied stove.
 - 1949**: New Main Terminal opens and renamed Seattle-Tacoma International Airport. Annually serves 130,000 passengers.
 - 1973**: Major construction program completed: New Main Terminal, North & South Satellites, underground Satellite Transit System, parking garage, and airport road system.
 - 1992**: Total renovation and expansion of Concourses B, C, and D completed. Airport road system.
 - 2004**: Completion of new South Main Terminal and Concourse A.
 - 2005**: Central Terminal expansion completed.
 - 2008**: New third runway opens.
 - 2018**: D Annex opens.
 - 2021**: New IAF and the renovated North Satellite are completed.
 - 2023**: Central Terminal renovation completed.
